Cherry Hinton Hall lake and waterways

The works on the lake and associated waterways in Cherry Hinton Hall are largely complete. It is now possible to see the deeper channel created through the centre of the lake and in due course the shallower side areas will form marshy areas – some additional plants may be added. Once the bird nesting season is over, the woodland area will be tidied up and the footpaths finished.

The invasive New Zealand Pygmyweed (*Crassula helmsii*) is still a problem (see our February newsletter, issue 51, for a photo). If you see any of this, please let us know but do not try to pull it out yourself – even small broken pieces can spread. We will be discussing with Guy Belcher and the City Council the best options for trying to control this and prevent its spread downstream.
